1st Quarter

Directions: Connect the term with its definition.

Piano (<i>p</i>)	4 beats in a measure and each quarter note receives a beat
Forte (<i>f</i>)	determines the <u>speed</u> of the music
Mezzo Forte (<i>mf</i>) –	play music medium loud
Mezzo Piano (<i>mp</i>) –	to start a note with the tongue
Dynamics –	how you start and stop a note
Slur –	play music medium soft
Tonguing –	determines the rhythmic division of the music
Tempo –	play music loudly
Articulation –	determines the <u>volume</u> of the music
Moderato –	play music softly
4/4 –	medium speed or medium tempo
Meter Signature –	to only tongue the first note in a group of notes

Eighth notes receive ___beat

Quarter rests receive ___ beat
